All birds participating in Fly Day with the Northwest Avian Flyers will be examined by an avian veterinarian every 18 months, and the veterinarian must confirm that the disease tests have been performed at either the **University of Georgia Laboratory** or **Molecular Diagnostics Lab, Ohio** and are within normal limits. We prefer the use of a board certified avian veterinarian. Currently, there are five in the Greater Seattle area. If an avian veterinarian is not available in your area, the situation will be reviewed case by case.

Please ask the veterinarian to check the applicable boxes to indicate which exams/tests were performed for this bird. All applicable tests must be performed before attending Fly Day.

- Physical examination by an avian veterinarian. Date: _____
- Complete Blood Count.
- Blood chemistry panel (Ba, AST, liver values, kidney, total protein, calcium, Ck, cholesterol).
Preferred labs for CBC & Blood Chemistries: Calif. Avian or Avian & Exotic Lab, Ohio.
- Cultures (choana and cloaca).
- Chlamydomphila test (for cockatiels only) PCR test through UGA.
- Psittacine Beak and Feather Disease test for Old World species, one time only.
- Polyomavirus vaccine if the bird is under one year old. All eclectus.
